

Application Guidelines for The University of Tokyo - JAGAM Supplementary Scholarship
for 2016 September Enrollment

Scholarship Benefits	A one-way economy class airline ticket from Malaysia to Narita/Haneda International Airport and a return economy-class ticket from Narita/Haneda International Airport to Malaysia upon completion of bachelor's degree
Number of Recipients	Up to 3 successful applicants will receive the Scholarship.
Award of Scholarship	At the time of enrollment and graduation

Eligibility for Application	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants must satisfy all application eligibility criteria as stipulated under the "Eligibility" section of the "The University of Tokyo College of Arts and Sciences Programs in English at Komaba (PEAK) Application Guidelines for September 2016 Enrollment" document. http://peak.c.u-tokyo.ac.jp/admissions/index.html 2. Applicants must be Malaysian citizens and intend to keep the visa status of "College Student" after their matriculation at the University of Tokyo.
Terms and Conditions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recipients must matriculate at the University of Tokyo on 1 September 2016, with the intention of completing the program at the University of Tokyo. 2. Recipients must not hold any other scholarships which cover travel expenses at the time of their matriculation at the University of Tokyo. 3. In the following cases, the University of Tokyo will notify JAGAM and the recipient may be ordered to return scholarship payments received up to the point of termination to JAGAM: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. If any of his/her application documents to the University of Tokyo are found to be falsely stated; b. If he/she is subject to disciplinary action by the University of Tokyo, such as expulsion or removal from the registration; c. If it becomes evident that he/she will not be able to complete his/her course within the standard course term because of his/her poor academic achievement or suspension; d. If his/her resident status of "College Student" changes to any other status; e. If the University of Tokyo and/or JAGAM determine(s) that he/she is unsuitable as a scholarship recipient because of justified reasons. 4. To qualify for the return ticket, recipients must return to Malaysia within 3 months upon completion of their bachelor's degree and join JAGAM as a

	member. The ticket should not be paid by any third party.
Application and Selection Process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All PEAK Undergraduate Program applicants who satisfy the eligibility for the Scholarship are automatically considered as potential recipients of the Scholarship. There is no need to make a separate application for the Scholarship. 2. The University of Tokyo will recommend successful applicants who wish to accept the Scholarship to JAGAM. The applicants will be required to submit a separate application to JAGAM in order to be officially eligible to receive the Scholarship. 3. JAGAM will award the Scholarship to the applicants.
