## TYCA Outline

Toshiba Youth Club Asia (TYCA) is a program that aims at creating a network of young Asian leaders who in the future will work towards building and strengthening peace and harmony in the Asia-Pacific region.

Selected High School students from Southeast Asian countries and from Japan will be invited to take part in an all-expense paid, one-week Exchange Camp in Tokyo.

The students will exchange views with each other and think about issues that will impact our future, such as world energy, disaster prevention, advanced technological solutions and more.

### Who can apply

Students who are aged between **15 and 18 years old** and enrolled as High School students at the time of the Camp (December 2015). Apart from that, interested applicants must be:

- Able to communicate and write essays in English
- Able to be in Tokyo from 19th – 26th December, 2015

#### Desirable:

- Students who are highly interested in Japan
- Students who have interest in promoting exchanges with other Asian countries
- Students who have studied Japanese before or who can speak basic Japanese (not mandatory)

### How to apply

Applicants must submit an Essay along with an Entry Form by **31st August**. Then, the Japan Alumni Association in each country will select two students based on their essays and qualifications.

1. Interested students must receive the application forms from their schools, which will also let the students know the email address to which the forms need to be sent (email address will be provided by the Japan Alumni Association in each country).
2. The applicants must fill out the forms and send them to the Japan Alumni Association by **31st August**.
